As a Teaching Assistant in our Hebrew and Judaic Studies programs, you will lead small groups and work one-on-one with students. You will receive individualized coaching from lead teachers and lead lessons of interest under the supervision of a mentor teacher. Fluency in Hebrew is essential for this position, as well as previous experience working with children. This is a part-time (25 hours per week) position with the potential to make it a full-time position with additional teaching support duties in General Studies.

- Work with small groups of students to support their academic and personal development.
- Aid in maintaining a positive and engaging learning environment.
- Collaborate with teachers to organize educational resources.
- Assist with assessments and record keeping.
